

Voter Registration

LCAD provides a Voter Registration Day each spring semester in partnership with American Association of University Women (AAUW) Laguna Beach.

- The College makes a good faith effort to distribute a mail voter registration form (for federal elections and state elections for governor or other State chief executive) to each student enrolled in a degree or certificate program and physically in attendance at the school
- The College makes a good faith effort in making the voter registration form widely available to students at the school
- Request the forms from the state 120 days prior to the deadline for registering to vote within the state This requirement does not apply to schools in states that do not have a voter registration requirement or that allow voters to register at the time of voting.
- The HEOA (Section 493(a)(1)) added the provision that a school will be considered to be in compliance with the distribution requirement if the school electronically distributes the voter registration form from an Internet address where such a form can be downloaded.
- The information must be in an electronic message devoted exclusively to voter registration. The Office of Student Life sends out this correspondence.
